

Bunny family, decorated with fabric découpage

Today we show you how to create a colourful bunny family as an Easter decoration using paint, markers and patchwork fabric.



1. Draw the outlines of the bodies of the rabbit family as templates on a sheet of paper. Copy these templates onto the fabric.



2. Cut out the templates.





3. Paint the edges of the bunny figures with craft paint - see photo.
Also apply a little colour to the body areas that will

later be covered with fabric.

4. Cut out the pieces of fabric and attach them to the bunny with decoupage varnish.



5. Cut out small flowers and bow ties from the fabric, the bow tie from double-layered fabric - see photo.



6. Stick the flowers to the ears with découpage varnish and the bow tie to the neck.



7. Paint the heads with découpage varnish. Once dry, draw the eyes on the heads with black Plus Colour Marker on the faces.
